Dear parents and students,






After thirty minutes, the old woman opened the door of the oven, the gingerbread man ran away! 'Wait!' said the woman and the man.

The pig and the gingerbread man swam across the river. Suddenly, the pig threw the gingerbread man high up in the air and he ate him! 'Yum!' said the pig.






A Fairy Tale

When David and Jimmy opened the gate, they saw many awful things




After that, David and Jimmy returned home. 'What should I do with the treasure? Buy a palace? Eat a buffet
