Greetings everyone,

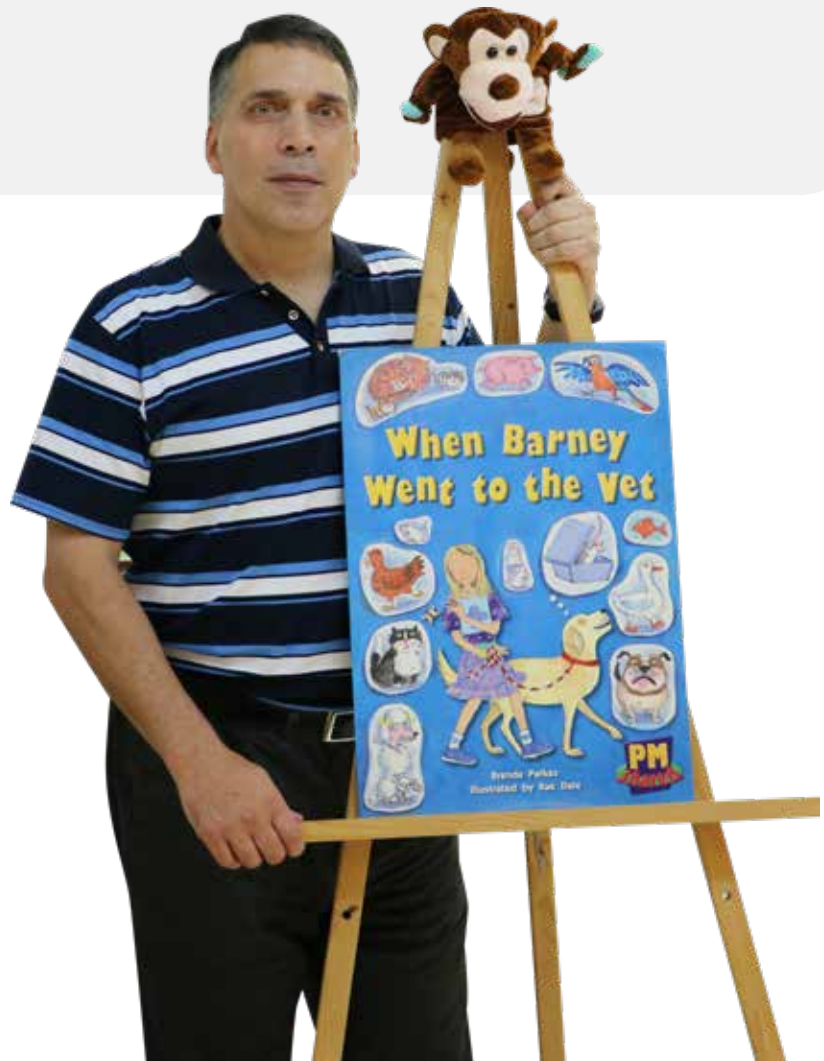

A Visit to the Home for the Elderly

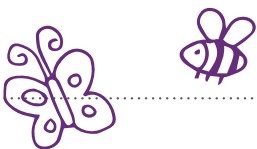
Last Saturday, I went to the home for the elderly in Tuen Mun with my friends. We got there by bus. It was great.

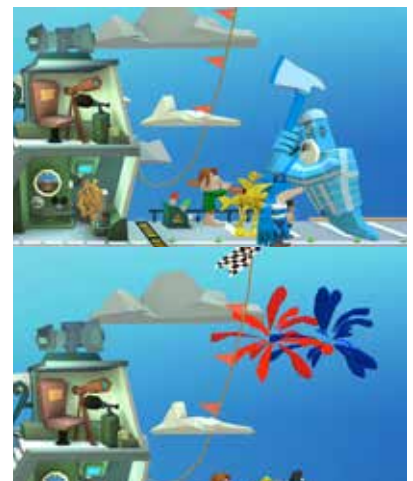


many things. The shark pirates said, 'I hate human pirates!'

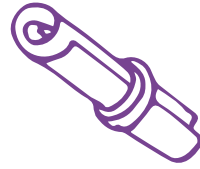
